
### 暑期课程查询

加州大学伯克利分校的暑期课程部门每年为学生提供 90 类学科, 600 多门暑期课程的选择。参加项目的学生可选择 1-2 门专业。一般暑期总时长为三周的课程选择 1 门专业课程, 暑期总时长为六周的课程选择 2 门专业课程。对应的学分主要是根据选择的专业课程。暑期主要有 A、B、C、D、E 共计 5 个 session。USIEA 本期访学生只能从 Session D 或者 Session E 两个时间段选择。专业课程主要集中在 Session D (6 weeks: July 2- Aug 10)。语言课程主要集中在 Session E (3 weeks: July 23 – Aug 10)。无论是专业类课程还是语言课程均是有学分 Unit 的。

**ABOUT THIS COURSE**

**Class Description 课程基本概述**

What is queer? Queer theorist Jasib Puar defines the term queer as "being strange in the world" (2007). In popular vernacular, the designation queer has come to signify a person with a sexuality that does not conform to cisgender, heterosexual physical, psychological, or spiritual norms. As Puar observes, queerness has come to be associated with white male secularity. This course challenges the normative classification of queer by exploring the ways in which the U.S.-Mexico and larger Latinx communities have expressed, practiced and represented queerness.

The process of "queering" involves exploring and interrogating "abnormalities" in the arenas of the personal and the social. This course will critically map the emergence of the queer as a public figure and trope in Chicana/o/x and Latina/o/x cultural and political life.

**Course Catalog Description 课程目录**

Topics in Latino/a-related art, history and contemporary issues, such as neighborhood development (e.g., Fruitvale neighborhood of Oakland, Mission district of San Francisco), mural arts movements, Spanish-language media, labor history, unionization efforts, immigration, demographic shifts, regional economic and/or social history, and transnational communities. Course topics will vary with the expertise of the particular instructor.
